

(Groovefest will take place rain or shine, but we reserve the right the cancel the event in case of lightning or inclement violent weather.)

Completed applications preferably received no later than **October 1st**, **by 5PM**, but we will accept applications (depending on available space) until the Friday before the event. The city mandates a \$10 fee for non-food vendors (+ \$30 for food vendors if - and only if - the health department chooses to make an inspection). Groovefest itself only hopes for your donation, or your time, so we may continue to promote a healthy local and global community through arts, music, and human rights awareness in the future.

KEEP THIS PAGE FOR YOUR RECORDS

- 1. WHERE: Andrews Park Amphitheater, 201 West Daws Street, Norman Ok 73069.
- 2. WHEN: October 7th, 2018; CHECK IN at 11am at the Groovefest Table BEFORE you set up. NO EARLIER THAN 11 AM PLEASE. The event begins at 12PM and ends at 9PM
- 3. <u>BRING:</u> Lights and extension cords if you plan to stay after dark. Sundown is expected at 7:30PM. There will be no electricity after 8PM and we must be out of the park by 10:00 pm. Please bring your own tables, tents, chairs, lights, booth, paper weights, props or other items. We will have recycling bins Please recycle and help keep the park clean!
- 4. <u>PARK:</u> OUT OF THE PARK. NO vehicles are permitted on grass, except for QUICK loading and unloading. (Exceptions made for Food Vendors only.)
- 5. <u>PAY:</u> \$10 vendor fee by mail BEFORE THE EVENT. It is required by city ordinance plus any tip-the-host donation to GF before you leave. There is an additional \$30 fee for FOOD VENDORS required by and for the Health Department *only if* they choose to perform an inspection.
- 6. <u>BE SURE:</u> You leave your tabling area at least as clean as you found it. Groovefest simply asks that as a group we show respect for one another.
- **7.** For any other concerns such as other tables, volunteers or attendees please contact the event coordinator.


City of Norman Rules and Regulations:

It is unlawful for any person to do or cause to be done any of the following acts within any public park or facility under the jurisdiction of the City of Norman Parks and Recreation Department:

- 1. To drive or park any motorized vehicle in (THE PARK) except upon a paved way.
- 2. Make fire in any park area except in places provided for such purposes.
- 3. Smoking and alcohol are prohibited in all Norman City Parks. Take a walk or use the parking lot.
- 4. To damage or remove any tree or plant, or damage or remove any park facility or property.
- 5. To litter or leave debris in any park area or facility. Please recycle!

 The City of Norman and Norman Groovefest disclaims any and all responsibility for accidents or injuries occurring during the time of your use of this facility.
